

## RARE CASE REPORT ON PLACENTA ACCRETA IN UNSCARRED UTERUS

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### ABSTRACT

*Placenta Accreta in an unscarred uterus without risk factor is a rare event in pregnancy and may cause life-threatening hemorrhage which requires a multidisciplinary approach. Incidence of Placenta Accreta without previous uterine surgery is associated with 1-5% risk. 30yrs old second gravida who was found to have central Placenta Previa on 2ND Trimester USG while patient was taken for Emergency LSCS at Gestational Age 37 weeks +2 days .On Intra operatively was found as Placenta Accreta, and patient had profuse bleeding for which medical management and uterine artery ligation, Internal Iliac artery ligation was done and failed, so we proceeded with Emergency Peripartum Hysterectomy. The predominant indication for Emergency Peripartum Hysterectomy was abnormal placentation like Placenta Previa/ Accreta which was noted in 45- 73.3%*
