### **ABSTRACT**

Amoxil is used to treat infections caused by bacteria that are B-lactamase negative (B-lactamase positive bacteria are usually resistant to Amoxil); these infections are usually occur in the skin, lungs, urinary tract and eye, ears, nose, and throat. Amoxil may be combined with other agents (for example, clavulanic acid [Augmentin],) to make the antibiotic more effective. Common side effects of Amoxil include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain, vaginal itching or discharge, headache, rash, and swollen, black, or "hairy" tongue.
